 the Governour for the Sum being and his
 Successors in the pinal sum of \$50 to
 which payment Will and truly to be
 made We bind our selves our heirs &
 Jountly and severally firmly by these
 presents Sealed With our seals and dated
 this 5th day of Dec^r 1806

The Conditions of the above obligation
 is such that Whereas there is a Marriage
 of shortly intended to be solemnized between the
 above bound Thomas Easter for which a
 Licence has I fear now if there should be
 no Lawful Cause to obstruct said Marriage
 then this obligation to be void as to
 remain in full force and effect

said marriage then this Obligation to
be void else to remain in full force and
