Now all men by their presents that we ~~Josiah~~ Joseph Chambers<sup>1-3</sup>  
 & David Snodgrass are here and fully bound  
 unto his Excellency Charles Scott Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor of this Commonwealth  
 & his Successors in office in the penal sum of £50 for the payment of  
 which we bound our selves and are by our selves & family  
 by this present seal with our seals & dates this 9<sup>th</sup>  
 day of August - 1809

The Condition of the above obligation is such that  
 if there be no legal cause to oblige a marriage wholly  
 intended to be solemnized between the said ~~Josiah~~ Joseph Chambers  
 & Polley Lacy
