and firmly bound unto his Excellency Charles Scott Governor  
of the Commonwealth in the Penal sum of Fifty  
Pounds ~~sterling~~ for which payment well and truly to be made  
we bind our selves our heirs executors and Administrators  
firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated  
the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1810.

The condition of the above  
obligation is such that whereas a Marriage is shortly intended  
to be solemnized between the said Ashly Duncan and  
Rebekah Robinson for which a license has issued

Now if there is no legal cause to obstruct the said marriage  
then this obligation is void but otherwise it remains  
in full force and virtue

**K**NOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we *Aaron Lewis* <sup>2-2</sup>  
*P. Martin Grier* and  
*Charly Scott* are held and firmly bound unto his excellency  
Esq. Governor of the commonwealth of Kentucky,  
in the penal sum of fifty pounds, which payment well and truly to be made to said  
Governor, or his successor in office, we bind ourselves and each of our heirs, &c.,  
jointly, severally and firmly by these presents. Sealed and dated this 13<sup>th</sup> day of  
*May* 1810

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas, there has a licence  
issued for a marriage, shortly intended to be solemnized between the above bound

*Aaron Lewis* and *Jenny Bratton*  
Now if it shall always hereafter appear, that there is no lawful cause to obstruct said  
marriage, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force & virtue.

whereof, we bind ourselves, our heirs, &c. jointly and severally, firmly by these presents,  
sealed with our seals, and dated this 24 day of January 1810

THE condition of this obligation is such, that if there should be no legal cause to  
obstruct a marriage shortly intended to be solemnized between the said *Allen Thompson* son  
of *Elizabeth Thompson* & *Sarah Barnett* daughter of said  
*James Barnett*

Then this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.
