ourselves, our heirs, &c. jointly, severally and firmly, by these presents. Sealed
with our seals, and dated this 10th day of July 1813

The condition of this obligation is such, that if there should be no legal cause
to obstruct a marriage shortly intended to be solemnized between the said

James Ford and Polly Wiley,
both above the age of 21 years

then this obligation to be void, else remain in full force and virtue.

Know all men by these presents, that we *Richard Lamastus* ^{Lamastus} *Lemaskas* ^{N 2-2}
William White are held and firmly bound unto the commonwealth
of Kentucky in the penal sum of £ 50, for the true payment whereof we bind
ourselves, our heirs, &c. jointly, severally and firmly, by these presents. Sealed
with our seals, and dated this *19th* day of *October* 181*3*

The condition of this obligation is such, that if there should be no legal cause
to obstruct a marriage shortly intended to be solemnized between the said *Richard*
Lemaskas *about 21 years old* and *Miss Betsey White*
daughter of S. William

then this obligation to be void, else remain in full force and virtue.
