Scaled with our seals and dated this *15th* day of *November* 1821

THE condition of this obligation is such, that if there should be no legal cause to obstruct a marriage shortly intended to be solemnized between the said *George Crabb* over the age of 21 & *Katharine Hampton* over the age of 21 for which a license has issued

then this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force.
