Administrative History: L.T. Smith arrived at Western and began an industrial arts program in 1920 called Manual Training as part of the College of Education. The first students with a Bachelor's degree in Industrial Arts graduated in 1930. The first woman in Kentucky to graduate with an Industrial Arts degree was Agnita Ruff in 1965.

The department was moved to Ogden College of Science & Engineering in 1972. It was combined with Engineering from 1981-1989 to form Industrial & Engineering Technology (UA66.17). The name changed to Architectural & Manufacturing Sciences in May 2000.
