Administrative History: African American fraternity colonized November 11, 1968 and chartered as Epsilon Rho chapter May 10, 1969 at WKU. The fraternity was mentored by members of the Scrollers Club.

The bylaws state the purpose of the fraternity as five-fold:

- 1) united college men of culture, patriotism, and honor in a bond of fraternity;
- 2) encourage honorable achievement in every field of human endeavor;
- 3) promote spiritual, social, intellectual and moral welfare of members;
- 4) assist the aims and purposes of colleges and universities; and
- 5) inspire service in the public interest.
