***COLLECTION NOTES***

This collection contains material assembled for the "Scraps to Quilts: Derby Fabrics, Women's Quilts, and Family Stories" exhibit created by Camilla Collins and her Applied Folklore class and Michael Ann Williams and her Cultural Conservation class. The Union Underwear Company operated a plant on Church Street in Bowling Green, Kentucky. Local quilters used scraps from the plant to make quilts, examples of which were displayed in the exhibit. Preparation began in January, and the exhibit ran from May through October 1986. The collection includes the exhibit guest register, memorandum, news releases, publicity material, data sheets about the quilts and quiltmakers, exhibit labels, oral interviews, and photographs. All staples have been removed, and the materials were placed in acid-free folders.
