Know All Men by these Presents, That we are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Kentucky in the penal sum of L50, for the true payment whereof, we bind ourselves, our heir, &c., jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals, and dated this *26* day of *November* 1839. The condition of this obligation is such, that if there should be no legal cause to obstruct a marriage shortly intended to be solemnised between the said *Joseph Bridges* and *Elizabeth Marget Griswold* for which a Licence is about to issue, then this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.
