Repariah Seay* are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Kentucky in the penal sum of L50, for the true payment whereof, we bind ourselves, our heir, &c., jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals, and dated this *18* day of *January* 183*1*. The condition of this obligation is such, that if there should be no legal cause to obstruct a marriage shortly intended to be solemnised between the said *Joshua Knowles* and *Elizabeth C. Kirby* for which a Licence is about to issue, then this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.

The condition of this obligation is such, that if there should be no legal cause to obstruct a marriage shortly intended to be solemnized between the said *John M. Tarrant* and *Nancy Potter* for which a Licence is about to issue, then this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.

Tarrant* having executed bond as the law in such cases requires. Witness my hand as Clerk of the County Court of said county, this 23 day of September 1837
