The Freshmen Class of Western Kentucky State College met in special session in Van Meter Auditorium on Monday afternoon at 3:30 P.M., October 4, 1954 for the purpose of electing officers. Assistant to the President, Kelley Thompson presided in the absence of Freshmen Class Sponsor, Mr. E. H. Canon, while Mrs. Edythe Utley acted as recording secretary.

The order of business was as follows:

The motion was made and seconded that each candidate for office be presented for a brief statement. The motion carried.

In addition to the previously selected candidates, Mr. Janes moved that we allow two other names to be submitted as candidates for that office. The Motion was seconded and carried by a majority.

Mr. Jones nominated Mr. William Owen and Mr. Forsythe nominated Mr. Randell Harper as candidates for the office of Sgt.-of-Arms along with William Ray Jacobsen, Gordon Jones, and Keith Gabehart. The candidates came to the stage.

Mr. Rash moved that there be a two-minute time limit on each candidate's speech. After a brief discussion the motion was withdrawn and Mr. Janes moved there be a thirty-second limit on speeches. Mr. Henry seconded the motion and it carried. The candidates gave their speeches.

In addition to the candidates for Treasurer: Shirley Fulkerson, Jeanne Jones, and Thelma Borders, Mr. Henry nominated Patsy Parrish and Miss Brawner nominated Marilyn Taylor. The candidates came to the stage and presented their speeches.

In addition to the candidates for Secretary, Shirley Ann Chandler, Myrna Wiley, and Shirley Barnes, Mr. Harper nominated Faye Brawner and Mr. Rider nominated Joyce Furnish. The candidates came to the stage and were presented for their speeches.

Miss Day nominated Ann Harrison and Mr. Kemker nominated Thea Dillingham along with Charles Roberts, Cleo McClellan, and Henry Earl Resch as candidates for the office of Vice-Pres.

In addition to the candidates for President, Jim Owens, Joe Sharp and Dalton Bruce Stewart, - Miss Hardy nominated Jim Dotson and Mr. Grossthaite nominated Owen Lawson on behalf of the basketball team. There was some discussion about allowing more candidates for President because of the importance of the job, but it was decided by vote that the previously approved motion of allowing only two additional candidates be followed, thus closing the floor for nominations with a total of five candidates. The speeches were made by the candidates.

Each Freshman present cast a secret ballot for the candidates of his choice and the meeting adjourned.
