MINUTES

COUNCIL OF ACADEMIC DEANS

May 1, 1979

The meeting was called to order at 9:10 a.m. by Dr. Davis. In attendance were Deans Gray, Hardin, Russell, Nelson, Sutton, Chelf, Mounce, Hourigan, Sandefur, and Stroube.

The minutes of the April 17 meeting were approved as distributed.

Dean Hourigan discussed the five-year health strategy plan from the Health Systems Agency West. He invited the deans to read any parts of it they desired.

A question relative to the period covered by the deans' annual reports was raised. Dr. Davis indicated that this would be checked out and the deans informed.

Dr. Davis informed the deans that the Departments of Government and Sociology, Anthropology, and Social Work will be shifted to the Office of Academic Affairs, effective August 16, 1979, until permanent assignment is determined.

Questions concerning budgets and administrative salary schedules were raised and discussed briefly. Dr. Stroube distributed copies of a memorandum from Mr. Largen clarifying the tuition waiver for faculty and staff taking courses during the summer under the new two-term format.

The meeting adjourned for a tour of the Kentucky Building at 9:30 a.m.
