MINUTES

Council of Academic Deans
September 11, 1979

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Dr. William Stroube, who presided in the absence of Dr. Davis. Deans in attendance were Gray, Sutton, Chelf, Russell, Nelson, Hardin, and Hourigan. Dr. Kenneth Brenner attended for Dean Sandefur; Mr. John Oakes attended for Dean Mounce.

The minutes of the July 24, 1979, meeting were approved as distributed.

The minutes of the August 28, 1979, meeting were approved as distributed.

Dr. Stroube commented on the importance of early decisions in respect to faculty members eligible for tenure in 1980, and he called attention to the information distributed concerning currently tenured faculty by college and department.

Dr. Stroube distributed a memorandum requesting bound faculty publications to be placed on "permanent" display in the Regents Room after being displayed in an appropriate display during Homecoming.

Dr. Gray initiated a discussion of general education.

Dr. Sutton presented the latest enrollment figures for fall 1979. In comparison with the comparable date last year, the university is down 473 headcount (mostly part-time and more at the graduate than at the undergraduate level). The number of first-time full-time freshmen for fall 1979 exceeds the number of first-time full-time freshmen for the comparable date fall 1978.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:05 a.m.
