

Minutes of Board Meeting

August 21, 1954

The Board of Regents of the Western Kentucky State College met in the home of President Paul L. Garrett Saturday afternoon, August 21, 1954, at 2 p.m. Present were State Superintendent Wendell Butler, ex-officio chairman of the Board, Regents Clarence Bartlett and John E. Richardson. Miss Florence Schneider, Bursar, and Mr. Kelly Thompson, Assistant to the President, were also present.

The chairman called the meeting to order and upon investigation declared a quorum to be present.

President Garrett reported that the College had received a check in the amount of \$9,350.00 in payment for the 18.7 acres of land sold to the Detrex Corporation. After a discussion it was agreed that this money together with the \$1,950.00 received from the sale of two trailers and three quonsets in Veterans Village should be deposited in a separate account and earmarked as capital outlay.

The next item discussed was the \$5,000.00 bequeathed to Western Kentucky State College in the will of Carolyn H. Snell. Mr. Bartlett moved with a second by Mr. Richardson that the money be deposited at the best interest rate available in an institution protected by FDIC, and the interest therefrom used for a scholarship fund. A vote being taken and all members voting in the affirmative the Chairman declared the motion adopted.

President Garrett next reported that the auditors were here bringing the books up-to-date and that the College is installing and will use a bookkeeping machine.

President Garrett presented the budget for the year 1954-55. After an examination and discussion of the budget Mr. Bartlett moved that the budget as presented be accepted. With a second by Mr. Richardson and with all members voting "aye" the motion was declared adopted.

President Garrett submitted a list of the personnel of the College with salary increases for the year 1954-55 and recommended its adoption. Mr. Bartlett moved that the salary increases as recommended by the President be approved. The motion was seconded by Mr. Richardson and unanimously adopted, all members voting "aye".
