Student Mentor Program
April 7, 1998

- PURPOSE:** For the University to develop a student mentor program that will offer extra aid to freshmen and sophomores at WKU.
- WHEREAS:** New students often need someone with a student perspective to answer questions about majors, classes, teachers and campus life, and
- WHEREAS:** A student mentor program consisting of juniors and seniors who volunteer as mentors would provide such a student perspective, and
- WHEREAS:** The program would allow students to communicate with mentors inside or outside of their prospective majors in a casual environment, and
- WHEREAS:** Student mentors would complement the faculty advisors either as separate programs or as an extension of the current advisor system.
- THEREFORE:** Be it resolved that we, the members of the Student Government Association, do hereby recommend the University develop a student mentor program that will offer underclassmen peer advisement as a supplement to faculty advisement.
