Administrative History: "Le Cercle Francais was organized in September of 1925 and its object was 'donner aux membres une plus grande connaissance de la langue, de la vie, et de la litterature de la France et de nourri l'amitie entre la France et les Etats-Unis.'" [Roughly: to give the members a greater understanding of the language, life, and literature of France and to encourage goodwill between France and the United States. 1925 Talisman, p. 14 translation by April McCauley]
