This collection consists of materials compiled by Dianne Watkins for a project on Earl Hamilton Berkley and the Berkley family reunions (1929-1984), farm, and service station. It contains interviews conducted by Watkins with Earl H. Berkley; a transcript of that interview and two tape summaries of subsequent interviews with Berkley.
