COLLECTION

This collection consists of the extensive genealogical material Bob C. Law collected while researching the Hobday/Hobdy family. He provides historical information concerning the family's movements from Virginia to North Carolina to Tennessee to Kentucky during the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries. Data related to Law's specific line begins with his great-great-great-great grandfather Robert Hobday, Sr., born 13 May 1744 in Gloucester County, Virginia. After he moved to Bertie County, North Carolina, he married Talitha Cotton about 1763. By the time of his death in 1797 he was living in Sumner County, Tennessee and and fathered 12 children: Robert Hobday, Jr., Ripsey Ann (Hobday) Harrell, Hannah (Hobday) Blount, Edmond Hobday, Thomas Hobday, Elizabeth (Hobday) Rhodes, Patience (Hobday) Cartwright, William Hobday (Law's great-great-great grandfather), John W. Hobday, Talitha (Hobday) Byrn, Tabitha (Hobday) Howell, and Richard D. Hobday. The collection contains information on each child of Robert Hobday, Sr., their children, and the families into which they married. Extensive corollary information is presented on the Howell family. Also of interest is a copy of the 1895 journal of Alexander C. Cartwright, son of Patience (Hobday) and Jacob Cartwright, which provides detailed family information as well as insight into late nineteenth century life in the Sumner and Davidson County, Tennessee area. The collection also contains correspondence, family charts, photographs of family members and family graves, and photocopies of birth, marriage and death records.

Owing to the fact that much of the material in the collection is genealogical and governmental records photocopied from periodicals and books, those dates are not considered in the content headings of the folders.
