Dear Alumni Brother:

This communication is for the purpose of providing you with information as to the latest news from your Alumni Board and to invite you to attend the Southern Kentucky Alumni Association annual summer meeting.

As most of you already know, the Alumni Board has been working with the Fraternity house landlord to establish a lease with purchase option. Much to the Alumni Board's surprise, the landlord sold the Fraternity house to the Alpha Gamma Rho's Alumni Board. Our board is now faced with a serious housing problem in that there are no adequate houses available for lease. Zoning rights in Bowling Green are very restrictive, and houses available for purchase are priced between \$75,000.00 to \$105,000.00.

The Board is looking into our financial resources and is requesting assistance from National Headquarters. Nothing definite has been decided. If housing cannot be found, the undergraduates will have to move into dorms or private apartments. We all know how this would hurt them during rush; consequently, the Chapter's future will depend heavily upon us and our efforts to find adequate housing. Time and, possibly, personal financial resources may be required of each of us.

We still have some time before we have to move from the house. It was agreed that an Alumni Association meeting should be called as soon as possible. We have therefore, scheduled the Alumni's summer party and meeting for Saturday, July 21st. The Alumni Association meeting will be held at 12:00 noon at the house (1438 Chestnut Street), and the party will begin after the meeting.

It is vital that all Alumni in your area be contacted and encouraged to attend this meeting. Please ask them to be discussing possible housing options or money making projects which can be brought up at the meeting.

The summer party will consist of a cookout and beer keg party - paid for from our dues. This will be our last party at the current house, so let's plan to attend and enjoy it.

It is important that you contact me by phone or letter no later than Monday, July 16th to tell me who will be attending the meeting and party of July 21st. This will give us time to prepare for it and to order adequate provisions. As always, your wives, children or dates are encouraged to be there for the fun.
