Council of Academic Deans

April 15, 1986

Dr. Haynes called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m. Members present included Drs. Binder, Hellstrom, Gray, Hershberger and Petersen. Dr. Hoyt represented Dr. Kupchella and Dr. Pankratz represented Dr. Sandefur. Dr. Pat Pearson, Administrative Intern, was also present.

The minutes of the April 1 meeting were reviewed and approved.

Dr. Haynes reviewed the agenda of the AASCU meeting in Chicago which dealt with the future role and mission of these institutions.

After brief discussion, the deans agreed to reiterate their support for an expanded summer school schedule for 1987. A decision on this must be made soon if any change is to be implemented for next year.

The subject of mandatory advising was again discussed. Mandatory advising for majors is favored by Ogden and Potter Colleges, but no concensus was reached on how to deal with the various categories of declared and undeclared, traditional and non-traditional students.

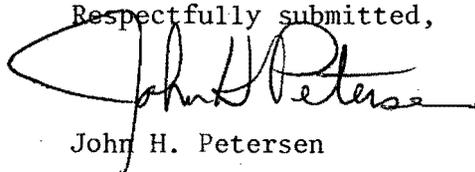
An inquiry from the National Science Foundation was considered about expanded participation in review panels by faculty from predominantly undergraduate institutions. The deans agreed that more faculty would participate if invited.

ASG resolutions on returning examinations and on the use of "staff" designations in schedule bulletings were discussed. Dr. Haynes will respond to the resolutions that examination policy is basically a faculty responsibility and that the use of "staff" designations will be limited to appropriate administrative purposes.

Dr. Hellstrom reported that the proposed changes in the English general education curriculum are being submitted to the college curriculum committees for discussion and to the General Education Committee and the Academic Council for decision later this month.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
