MINUTES

Council of Academic Deans

August 5, 1986

Dr. Haynes called the meeting to order at 10:45 a.m. Members present included Drs. Sandefur, Kupchella, Hellstrom, Gray, Binder, Hershberger, Sutton and Petersen.

The minutes of the July 22 meeting were reviewed and approved.

Dr. Haynes briefly described the ceremony recently held in San Diego to recognize outstanding innovative programs at AASCU institutions. Western was one of five institutions honored.


The deans retreat was tentatively set for September 19-20.

Dr. Gray distributed an extensive report on extended programs which provided information on demographic and educational characteristics of the university's primary service area. He outlined some of the challenges and obstacles and provided a recommended plan of action.

Dr. Sutton discussed progress on the community college. There was extensive discussion of issues involved. Dr. Haynes expressed the view that the community college should move to independent courses, programs, faculty and admissions as rapidly as possible. The development of the community college will be discussed at a meeting with deans and department heads scheduled for August 7.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:30 p.m.
