MINUTES

Council of Academic Deans

August 11, 1987

Dr. Haynes called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present included Drs. Sandefur, Hellstrom, Binder, Sutton, Wassom and Petersen. Mr. Lynn Greeley represented Dr. Kupchella.

Dr. Haynes made brief announcements and the minutes of the July 14 meeting were approved as written.

Dr. Sandefur provided a brief report on his recent visit to China. He reported that sister school relationships have been signed with several Chinese institutions and that many opportunities for exchange will be available for faculty and students.

Dr. Haynes announced that the next meeting of the Board of Regents will be September 10.

Dr. Sutton led a discussion of academic advising. He requested names of additional faculty who could assist with advising undecided students this fall. The new advising system plan was also briefly reviewed and will be finally decided at the next meeting.


The pre-college curriculum was discussed with specific references to how entering students with deficiencies will be handled. No resolution was reached and Dr. Sutton will consult with Mrs. Chambless regarding data on these students.

The copyright policy proposal was discussed and, after some modifications, was approved.

The proposed sick leave policy for faculty was discussed at length but no consensus was reached.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:00 noon.
