MINUTES

Council of Academic Deans

March 15, 1988

Dr. Haynes called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present included Drs. Gray, Hellstrom, Binder, Wassom, Kupchella and Petersen. Dr. Martray represented Dr. Sandefur and Mrs. Frieda Eggleton and Mrs. Sharon Dyrsen represented Dr. Sutton.

Dr. Haynes announced that the university-high school visitation day at Bowling Green High School has been set for April 5.

There was a discussion of enrollment and course offerings for the Fall 1988 Semester. Dr. Haynes advised the deans and department heads to make plans for the Fall based on the assumption that there will be no significant increase in resources over last year.

The draft revisions in the policy on supplementary pay for faculty prepared by Dr. Kupchella was circulated and discussed.

A proposed policy on transferability of community college courses was discussed at length. Some modifications were suggested in the draft prepared by Dr. Haynes. The general purpose of the policy is to insure that normally community and junior college courses will transfer for lower division credit only. There was consensus that the revised policy should be implemented, provided that adequate notice is given to the community colleges and prospective transfer students.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
