Buy-A-Book Program for Fall 2007 Semester

- PURPOSE:** For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to distribute \$2000 dollars for the Buy-A-Book Program, which offers book scholarships for Western Kentucky University students.
- WHEREAS:** The \$2000 will be divided between twenty Western Kentucky University students to assist in the costly book buying effort, and
- WHEREAS:** The Student Government Association annually sets money aside for such a program in order to financially aid Western Kentucky University students, and
- WHEREAS:** Through a formal publicity campaign, the Student Government Association will attain a higher application entry level than in past years consequently increasing the number of students who apply significantly, and
- WHEREAS:** A scholarship selection committee, selected and chaired by the Academic Affairs Chairman, shall be made up of one faculty member, The Student Government Director of Student and Academic Affairs or his designate, one Student Senator, and three Academic Affairs committee members; one of which is not in Student Senate, shall sit on the selection committee, and
- WHEREAS:** An application, which is attached, will aid in the selection of the said worthy students, and
- WHEREAS:** The applying process shall begin no later than April 16<sup>th</sup> 2007, and end no sooner than April 27<sup>th</sup> 2006, and the selection committee will meet during the week of April 30<sup>th</sup> 2006 through May 4<sup>th</sup>
