***COLLECTION NOTE***

This collection consists of a class project titled “Rocky Hill Station Architecture” completed in the Spring semester of 1988 for Dr. William Lynwood Montell’s vernacular architecture class. The project includes photocopies of photographs featuring people and buildings, photographs of community buildings, and oral history interviews with various residents of the Rocky Hill community in Edmonson County, Kentucky. The interviews were recorded on cassette tape and are indexed. Topics include architecture, social life, economic life and railroads. Several of the taped interviews were not submitted with the project, but an index based on the tapes was included; it was decided to retain these indexes despite the fact that the tape does not exist.
