BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE (ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY)

COLLECTION NOTE

This collection consists of interviews by Annie Archbold with ten rural women, all members of Warren County homemakers clubs, and three former Kentucky Agriculture Extension Agents who served in Warren County. Informants discuss the establishment of Home Demonstration Clubs in the county beginning in 1931 under the direction of Zilphia Foster, and funded by the Warren County Fiscal Court, the purpose and impact of the program, and membership in homemaker clubs for adult women, and 4-H Clubs for children, 1931-1986. Early programming for Warren County women included courses on home food preservation, using electricity and electrical appliances in the home, establishing school cafeteria programs, and establishing farmers markets. During World War II, programming included courses on the history and geography of Europe, the establishment of Victory Gardens, school nutritional programs and immunization programs for children. In addition to discussion of the program's establishment and early programming, informants provide information regarding Warren County homemakers clubs post World War II to present, and agents compare the evolution of the program, and the role of County Extension agents in the program. In 1986, more than 500 Warren County women were members of 30 clubs throughout the South Central Kentucky county.
