***COLLECTION NOTE***

This collection documents the Artists in Residence (AIR) Program, a joint project of the Kentucky Folklife Program and the Kentucky Arts Council. Folk artist Sue Masek documented folk traditions in Bourbon County, Kentucky and then presented those traditions with students and teachers at Bourbon Central Elementary School through in-class instruction and special programs by local folk artists. Local history and architecture, dance, music, tobacco, woodworking, horses, and Jewish history were some of the traditions dealt with in this program. This collection includes field notes, a survey report, slides and indices, audiocassette tapes and indices and videocassette tapes (VHS).
