***COLLECTION NOTE***

This collection features oral histories gathered from members of the First Baptist Church located in Frankfort, Kentucky. Organized in 1833, issuing an integrated worship, the church was established by John Ward and Zioh Black. Some church history has been documented with written materials such as anniversary programs, but much of it remains simply in memory of members. This is the church's first attempt to capture the memories and experiences of older members through recorded interviews. The project was started by Dr. Lee Harris in 2010 in honor of the church's upcoming 177<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration. All interviews are in digital format.
