Dr. Robert V. Haynes called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present included: Drs. Michael B. Binder, J. Michael Brown, Ronnie N. Sutton, Carl R. Martray, Martin R. Houston, David D. Lee, John H. Petersen, and Livingston Alexander.


Dr. Haynes provided a report on the November 8, 1993, quarterly meeting of the Council on Higher Education. He summarized discussion of the following issues: proposed tuition increase; alternative processes for funding higher education, including performance-based funding; list of priorities for capital improvements, including the EST Building renovation (which is third on the list); and the Common Course Numbering proposal which received CHE approval.

Next Dr. Haynes drew the attention of the council members to a November 5, memorandum from Kevin Hable in which he sought feedback from each institution regarding a list of possible performance measures. The memorandum elicited considerable discussion. Dr. Haynes agreed to summarize the discussion and provide feedback as requested.

Dr. Haynes, then, asked for final feedback, questions, or concerns about the Proposal for Library Advisory Committees. The Council of Deans approved the document as presented in its final form.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:45 a.m.
