COLLECTION NOTE

This collection features information about the “World of Our Own: Kentucky Folkways” television program series sponsored and produced by KET (Kentucky Educational Television) and premiered from 16-19 August 1998.

The series was shown over a four-day period with each featuring a specific type of folklife found in Kentucky. On Sunday, August 16, KET broadcast the “Culture of Work” program that focused on occupational traditions; on Monday, August 17, broadcast the “Culture of Play” program that focused on leisure-time activities; on Tuesday, August 18, broadcast the “Art of the Everyday” program that focused on useful beauty; and finally, on Wednesday, August 19, broadcast a program titled “Customs and Beliefs” focused on special events and folkways.

KET also produced a teacher’s guide to accompany the television program that summarized each segments of the series. It suggested ways to incorporate the series, and by extension the community’s own traditional culture, into classroom learning.
