COLLECTION NOTE

This collection features information and documentation of Wash's Cycles, a motorcycle shop in Lawrenceburg, Kentucky, and its connection with the Man O' War division of The Harley Owners Group located in Lexington, Kentucky. Established in 2000, Wash's Cycles is owned and operated by Gary Wash. The shop deals almost exclusively with Wild Turkey Choppers.

The Man O' War division of The Harley Owners Group was founded on 22 July 1987 and was sponsored by Lynn McGaughey. The H.O.G. meets regularly and schedule rides across the country. They also volunteer at local charities and host fundraising events.
