This collection features information and documentation of the Paul Sawyer Public Library's summer reading program held from June 6-July 29, 2011 at the Paul Sawyer Public Library in Frankfort, Kentucky. The program contained reading lists for children, teens, and adults to complete during the assigned time period. Once the required hours of reading were logged, the participant would be entered in a drawing for a special grand prize in the form of a gift card. In addition to the reading program, the Paul Sawyer Public Library also hosted numerous summer activities including but not limited to a Chinese shadow puppetry show, Flamenco dancing lessons, and a Mother-Daughter book club. All photos are available in digital format.

Paul Sawyer was born on 23 March 1865 in Madison County, Ohio. In 1870, he and his family moved to Frankfort, Kentucky. Sawyer became a prominent watercolor painter and was best known for his scenes in the Frankfort area. He is most renowned for his paintings of the Kentucky and Dix Rivers. Sawyer died on 5 November 1917 at the age of 52.
