COLLECTION NOTE

This collection features information and documentation of the “Kentucky Crafted: The Market” event held annually in Lexington, Kentucky. The collection focuses primarily on the markets from the year 2000 through 2012. “Kentucky Crafted: The Market” is the Kentucky Arts Council’s signature event produced each year in the spring featuring the highest quality art, craft, literature, music, film, and food found within the state. Hundreds of Kentucky and select out-of-state artists make their finest work available to wholesale buyers and the general public during the three-day event.

Kentucky is one of a few states in the nation to sponsor a show of this kind for its art and craft businesses. Since 1983, the tradition of excellence has served as a primary business venture for many local artists and craftsman. “Kentucky Crafted: The Market” was named the “No. 1 Fair & Festival” in the country four times by the readers of *American Style Magazine* and been named a “Top 20” event by the Southeast Tourism Society for the past 15 years.
