***COLLECTION NOTE***

This collection features information and documentation of the cultural traditions survey of the eastside neighborhood in Covington, Kentucky by folklorist Amy Slade. The survey itself is the result of a one-month inventory of residents, past and present, of the eastside neighborhood. The historically African American community has had little formal documentation of cultural traditions and heritage. The Covington Community Center was crucial in helping to receive a grant from the Kentucky Arts Council and the Kentucky Folklife Program for Amy Slade to interview local residents in order to compile a document of their cultural resources.

There are no actual interviews included in this collection.
