***COLLECTION NOTE***

This collection features an audio interview conducted by Larry Morrissey with Rude Osolnik on 18 March 1997. There is nothing else included with this collection. Rude Osolnik (1915-2001) was a wood turner and crafter who was born in New Mexico and later lived and worked in Berea, Kentucky. He taught in the Industrial Arts Department at Berea College for forty years. In 1950 he received a National Award for Contemporary Design from the International Wood Manufacturers. Between 1981 and 1987, he repeatedly served on the Board of Directors of the Southern Highlands Handicraft Guild, which honored him with a Lifetime Achievement Award in 1997. He was a founder, lifetime member, and Fellow of the Kentucky Guild of Artisans and Craftsmen and a Fellow of the American Craft Council. In 1992, he received the Kentucky Governor's Award for Lifetime Achievement in the Arts.
