Date organized: Jan. 28, 1934, Bowling Green Business University

Date reinstated: Sept. 21, 2012

House - 1410 College Street, 1970s

Formed January 28, 1934 as The Barons social fraternity by Sam Milner, Bill Bass and Charlie Gadd at Bowling Green Business University. The club was renamed Beta Alpha Rho in January 1964 and in October of the same year the group became Alpha Tau Omega. The local chapter is Zeta Omega. It appears to have disbanded circa 1977 and reinstated in 2012.

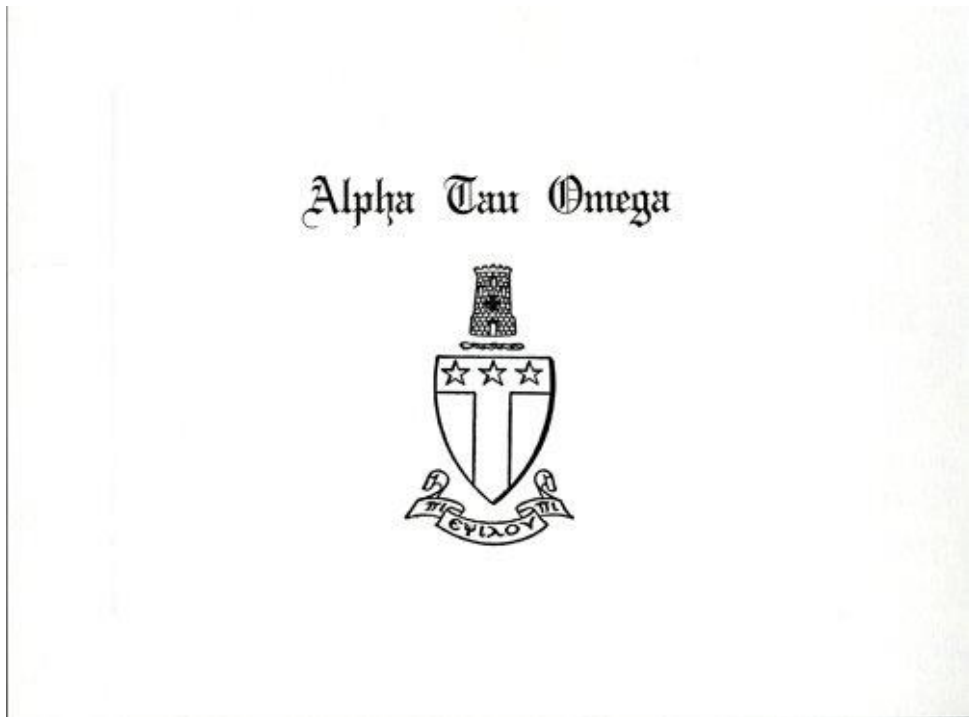
