COLLECTION NOTE

This collection consists chiefly of letters written by friends and family to Green County, Kentucky native Goff from 1903 to 1914. From 1903 to 1908 he was working as an agricultural laborer in Illinois, Minnesota, and Iowa and the letters are addressed to him at towns in those states. Goff had returned to Eve in Green County by 1909. The remaining collection letters are addressed to him there or, in 1913 and 1914, to a later home in Hobson, Taylor County, Kentucky. Also included are two 1913 letters to his wife Laura Goff from her mother and sister. Before his marriage Goff received many courtship letters from various women.
