COLLECTION NOTE

This collection contains information and documentation of the Kentucky Crossroads Community Scholars Cultural Survey Program sponsored by the Kentucky Folklife Program with support from the Kentucky Arts Council and in partnership with Preservation Kentucky. The program was opened to recent graduates of the Community Scholars Program and the RHDI (Rural Heritage Development Initiative) region in central Kentucky to conduct paid cultural surveys of the area. During the fall of 2007, Western Kentucky University graduate students from the Folk Studies and Anthropology department joined the Community Scholars participating in this project to review work completed and assist in continuing stages of the project.

The Community Scholars conducted research at the local level, archived the research both locally and with the Kentucky Folklife Program, and presented their research through a public program. The surveys included a minimum of ten recorded interviews, accompanying photographs, photo logs, recording logs, and field notes as well as consent forms, midpoint assessments, and documentation of public presentation of their research.
