The free six-workshop series taught individuals how to collect and preserve local history, identify and document community traditions, and present these traditions to the public. Participants were taught the basic skills needed to help communities explore and showcase local talent, folk traditions, and history. The sessions for this particular program were held at WKU's Pioneer Log Cabin every other week from 30 April to 9 July 2005. The Community Scholars Program was a partnership between the Kentucky Folklife Program, the Kentucky Historical Society, and the Kentucky Arts Council.
