This collection contains information and documentation about the Community Scholars Program's workshops held in Hart County, Kentucky during the summer of 2010. The collection features projects by all participants with special focus on the Mammoth Cave project by Del Maria Vaccaro and the oral recordings done by Mary Margaret Villines about Kentucky artist Joseph Dudley Downing. Instructors in the free six-workshop series taught individuals how to collect and preserve local history, identify and document community traditions, and present these traditions to the public. Participants learned the basic skills needed to help communities explore and showcase local talent, folk traditions and history. The sessions for this particular program were held every other week from 1 May 2010 to 10 July 2010. The Community Scholars Program is a partnership between the Kentucky Folklife Program, the Kentucky Historical Society, and the Kentucky Arts Council.
