The collection focuses on the project completed by participant Patty Coakley. Instructors in the free six-workshop series taught individuals how to collect and preserve local history, identify and document community traditions, and present these traditions to the public. Participants learned the basic skills needed to help communities explore and showcase local talent, folk traditions, and history. The sessions for the Jefferson County program were held every week from 15 February to 21 March 2008. The Community Scholars Program is a partnership between the Kentucky Folklife Program, the Kentucky Historical Society, and the Kentucky Arts Council.
