COLLECTION NOTE

This collection contains information and documentation about the “Church Traditions in Jackson County, Kentucky” project completed by community scholar Judy Ball. The project was funded by the Community Scholar Survey Grant Program, a grant which is only available to those who have successfully completed the community scholar program to conduct further research. The project was also funded by the Jackson County Development Association (JCDA), an all-volunteer committee dedicated to improving the quality of life in Jackson County, Kentucky.

The goal of the project was to research, document, and present the traditions of four local churches in Jackson County. These churches included the Faith Baptist Church, the Bond Holiness Church, the St. Paul’s Catholic Church, and the Anville Community Reformed Church. There are over one hundred churches in Jackson County that represent a wide variety of denominations. By documenting and presenting the traditions and beliefs of these churches, the project hoped to enhance cross-faith understanding and appreciation of the commonalities as well as the differences among beliefs. Besides the interviews that documented these four specific churches, Folders 3 and 4 includes survey sheets for dozens of churches in Jackson County. The forms generally include name, pastor’s name, service times, and a small color photograph of the church building. Some include the church’s phone number and directions to the building, while others only include the name of the church and the photo.
