First of all, let me apologize for not being able to attend the Faculty Senate meeting on September 8, 1994. As I discussed with you and the Executive Committee, I had already made plans to be out of town on that date. I also mentioned to you that my schedule had me out of the state on **October 13**, the date of the next Faculty Senate meeting. I have cancelled my plans for that date and **will be in attendance** at the Faculty Senate meeting at that time.

Thank you for forwarding to me a copy of the Faculty **Senate resolutions** passed at the September 8 meeting. Regarding the **first** resolution, I'm not sure in what format I will receive the college and vice presidential responses to the "Moving to a New Level . . ." proposal. Certainly, there are no secrets. I will keep you fully informed once those responses are received.
