

The writer wishes to place the name of Kelly Thompson in nomination for President Emeritus of Western State University; that he be furnished an office and Secretary so that his unbelievable influence with the student body and the thousands of alumni; that his and that his many warm personal contacts with so many influential people not be permitted to wither on the vine. Regardless of the qualifications of his successor, filling Kelly Thompson's shoes overnight is too much to expect of any man; the writer considers the Regents under the obligation of making the change gradual, which would be the case with Kelly as President Emeritus.
