Letter, 15 February 1921, from Sister Ethel Freda (Mary Ellen Melbourne), to a relative, Blanche Heckel, Vinita, Oklahoma. She mourns the death of Mother Aloysius, the convent's first Mother Superior, whom she had accompanied to California on a mission to improve her health.
