COLLECTION NOTE

This collection includes ten digital interviews that were conducted in 2013 by Stephen Ross Goddard, a student at Western Kentucky University, for his thesis, "Neither (Fully) Here Nor There: Negotiation Narratives of Nashville's Kurdish Youth." The folk studies thesis was an examination of how young immigrant Kurds (ages 16-26) located in Nashville, Tennessee, viewed their place within and/or apart from American culture and the Kurdish one into which they were born. Goddard's interviewees were chiefly female, but the content represented a healthy cross-section of experiences from third-culture youth. These digital interviews are stored in the Sound Archives. Transcripts for each interview are provided.
