SUN BELT MEETING

The Bid is open for the Sun Belt Tournament. The minimum bid is \$100,000 and Creative Sports will share or be a part of the Sponsorship, on a percentage basis. This bid will move the tournament around to the participating universities. After the bid is received all schools will participate in the upfront costs totalling \$27,000, so the true cost to the school receiving the bid is actually \$73,000.
