***BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION***

Maxey Barlow Harlin, Jr. was born 13 October 1915 in Bowling Green, Kentucky, the son of Maxey Barlow Harlin and Margaret (Franklin) Harlin. After graduation from College High and pre-law courses at Western Kentucky State Teachers College in his hometown, he graduated from the University of Louisville in 1938 with the LLB degree. He practiced law with his father at Harlin & Harlin before serving as a special agent for the Federal Bureau of Investigation during World War II. Later he became a partner with the firm Rodes, Harlin & Willock, then with the firm Harlin and Parker.

Harlin was a member of the American Bar Association, Kentucky Bar Association, Board of Regents of Western Kentucky University, Kiwanis Club, Fortnightly Literary Club, and the Presbyterian Church.

He was married to Nancy Moore. They had three children, Maxey Barlow Harlin III, John Moore Harlin, and Nancy Elizabeth Harlin. He died 8 October 2003 and is buried in Fairview Cemetery in Bowling Green. His wife and two sons preceded him in death.

***COLLECTION***

This collection consists chiefly of attorney Maxey B. Harlow, Jr.'s correspondence related to his membership on the Constitution Review Commission in the 1950s and the Constitutional Revision Assembly in the 1960s. The collection also includes minutes of the Constitution Review Commission as well as a paper by Hambleton Tapp, "Should Kentucky Revise her 1891 Constitution by Convention," and texts of speeches by former Governor Earle C. Clements and lawyer Samuel M. Rosenstein that support revision of the state's constitution.
