***ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY***

The Janice Holt Giles Symposium was held 17 and 18 May 1991 on the campus of Campbellsville College, Campbellsville, Kentucky. Symposium director Clara Metzmeier assembled several noted Kentucky authors and educators to present papers on such topics as feminism in Giles's novels, a sense of place in her works, and the folklore reflected in her fiction. Janice Holt Giles's daughter offered reminiscences of her mother and Wade Hall, associate symposium director, presented remarks about her husband Henry Giles. A readers' theater adaptation of Giles's short story "Adios Miss Em" was also performed for those in attendance.

This collection contains five videocassette recordings of the proceedings of the Janice Holt Giles Symposium, 17 and 18 May 1991.
