Elevated Grade Scale
Introduced: 02/01/83

Status: **PASSED**

Purpose: Establishment of an elevated grade scale

Whereas, Western Kentucky University is an institution of higher learning, and

Whereas, a student is graded on the basis of his or her performance in each of their classes, and

Whereas, there is often a wide gap between students final grade averages (example, eighty percent or eighty-nine percent), and

Whereas, under the present grading system, all students who fall within the ten (10) point spread will receive the same credit points,

Therefore, the Associated Student Government, being the voice of the student body, requests that the Board of Regents approve the following grade scale:

<u>Grade</u>	<u>Points</u>
D	1.0
D+	1.5
C	2.0
C+	2.5
B	3.0
B+	3.5
A	4.0

Furthermore, let it also be known that the new grading scale would be left to the teacher's discretion, and would be used as a reward for students showing work above normal points credit.
